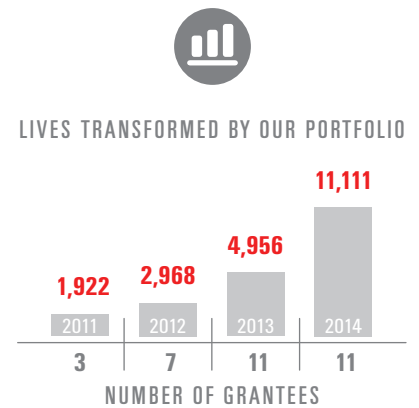


OUR MODEL: FIND. FUND. SCALE.

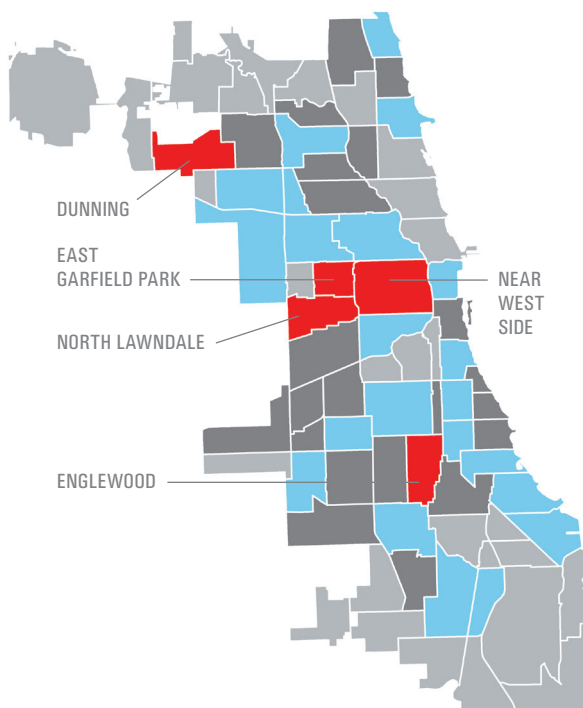

CITIZEN SCHOOLS

DESCRIPTION: Expanded learning time and apprenticeships for 6-8th grade
INVESTMENT: \$315K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2012
FY14 REVENUE: \$1.4M
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 340
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: Students gained an average of two academic years of learning in a core subject

EMBARC (2013 PROJECT IMPACT WINNER)

DESCRIPTION: Social and cultural enrichment experiences for high school students
INVESTMENT: \$100K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2013
FY14 REVENUE: \$0.6M
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 350
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: 98% of seniors graduated from high school over the past two years

KIPP CHICAGO SCHOOLS

DESCRIPTION: K-8th grade charter school network (4 schools)
INVESTMENT: \$450K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2013
FY14 REVENUE: \$15.7M
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 982
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: 80% of students met or exceeded academic growth targets

ONEGOAL

DESCRIPTION: Teacher-led three-year college access and persistence
INVESTMENT: \$565K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2011
FY14 REVENUE: \$2.5M
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 1,523
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: Added 12 school partners and increased student enrollment by 23%

GENESYS WORKS

DESCRIPTION: Internships and mentoring for high school seniors
INVESTMENT: \$225K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2012
FY14 REVENUE: \$0.9M (YTD)
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 128
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: 100% of students that completed the program enrolled in college

LEARN CHARTER SCHOOL NETWORK

DESCRIPTION: K-8th grade charter school network (8 schools)
INVESTMENT: \$875K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2011
FY14 REVENUE: \$34.1M
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 2,979
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: Opened a new campus for 1,400 elementary and middle school students

READING IN MOTION

DESCRIPTION: Arts-based early childhood literacy for K-1st grade
INVESTMENT: \$350K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2013
FY14 REVENUE: \$1.9M
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 3,875
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: Secured 12 new CPS partners for 2015 school year

JUMPSTART

DESCRIPTION: Preschool literacy
INVESTMENT: \$200K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2012
FY14 REVENUE: \$0.8M (YTD)
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 695
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: 65% of students were kindergarten ready

ONE MILLION DEGREES

DESCRIPTION: Support for community college students
INVESTMENT: \$350K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2013
FY14 REVENUE: \$1.5M
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 130
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: Piloted an expanded partnership with City Colleges of Chicago

UPWARDLY GLOBAL

DESCRIPTION: Job placement support for skilled, legal immigrants
INVESTMENT: \$100K + management support
INITIAL INVESTMENT YEAR: 2013
FY14 REVENUE: \$0.2M (YTD)
FY14 PARTICIPANTS: 109 (YTD)
FY14 HIGHLIGHT: Average placement salary is \$44K versus incoming salary of \$6K (YTD)
